PEEWEEES: Bowl 1 game. \$10.00 entry fee (\$4.00 Lineage; \$6.00 Prize Fund)
Award for highest game bowled (with handicap added) will be given. Scholarships will be awarded at a ratio of at least 1:2.

BANTAMS: Bowl 2 games. \$20.00 entry fee (\$8.00 Lineage; \$12.00 Prize Fund)
Award for the highest game bowled (with handicap added) will be given. Scholarships will be awarded at a ratio of at least 1:4.

PREPS: Bowl 4 games in a sweeper format. \$35.00 entry fee (\$16.00 Lineage; \$19.00 Prize Fund)
Total pin fall plus handicap determines finishing placement. Medals: 1st, 2nd, & 3rd place. Scholarships will be awarded at a ratio of at least 1:4.

JR/MAJORS: Bowl 4 games in a sweeper format. \$35.00 entry fee (\$16.00 Lineage; \$19.00 Prize Fund)
Separated into 2 divisions, by average; Division 1, 150 and above; Division 2, 149 and below. Total pin fall plus handicap determines finishing placement. Medals in each division: 1st, 2nd & 3rd place. Scholarships will be awarded at a ratio of at least 1:4.

TOURNAMENT RULES

1.ELIGIBILITY and ENTRY: Any USBC youth member bowling in USBC sanctioned league(s) within the association's jurisdiction for the 2026-2027 season. Each bowler must fill out this form and only one entry is allowed. Registration ends on November 2, 2026. However, late registration and walk-on will be permitted provided they bring this completed entry form including Youth Director's signature, and only if space is available with an additional \$5.00 fee.

2.AVERAGES: Will be the current highest sanctioned league average of the 2026-2027 season with 12 or more games bowled, except for PEEWEES division, by November 2, 2026 if not, then will use the highest ending sanctioned average of the last season (2025-2026) including summer averages with 21 or more games bowled. If the bowler does not have either average, then will be assigned average as follows: Bantams-100; Preps-149; Jr/Maj-210. All averages must be verified by the center's youth director.

3.HANDICAP: All divisions will be handicapped which will be from the individual's average of 90% off of 210.

4.SUBSTITUTES: Are allowed at tournament director's discretion provided they bring this completed entry form including Youth director's signature.

5.CHECK-IN: Starts 30 minutes before tournament starts. All bowlers must check-in at registration for lane assignments. Late arrivals may be permitted to bowl with zero score for frames missed.

6.TIES: All placements ties will be determined by bowlers highest scratch game bowled in this tournament.

7.ALL PRIZE FUNDS: Will be awarded in medals, trophies, and scholarships. Scholarships are placed within each bowler's SMART account after tournament ends in accordance with the SMART policies which is administered by the United States Bowling Congress. This program was selected to streamline the process for scholarship winners to access their funds. It will also allow up to eight years from the date they graduate high school to use the funds. 8.JUNIOR GOLD BOWLERS: This tournament event will hold, if able, a junior gold qualifying for the 2027 Junior Gold Championships. All bowlers competing for spots must be a current junior gold member prior to entering the qualifier event. Memberships are available for purchase day of tournament. All junior gold fees are additional to the Wy-Jon County USBC, Inc. Tournament entry fees. Additional rules and information are available at check-in day of tournament. All divisions must have at least 4 competitors in the division, to have that division able to hold the qualifier.
